



TOPIC: A VEGETABLE BY ANY OTHER NAME

National Curriculum Area/s: LOTE (Languages Other Than English – Indonesian)

Title: Vegetable picture and word match.

Year level(s): 4/5

Strands

- Form and features
- Intonation and pronunciation

Understanding Goals

- Use common Classroom vocabulary (FaF)
- Use Indonesian words for naming fruits and vegetables (FaF)
- Pronunciation of Indonesian alphabet eg *c*=ch, rolling *r* sound, vowel sounds (IaP)

Possible links to other curriculum areas

- Mathematics –Number: counting the number of vegetables/fruits using Indonesian numbers.
- Art – still line drawings.
- Viewing – Indonesian vegetable markets.

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ACTIVITY LESSON PLAN:

1. Children will do many oral sessions on the learning of names for the fruits and vegetables in English and Indonesian. They will then be introduced to various games of writing the missing label in Indonesian or English.
2. The children will play the concentration game using just words to match the English and Indonesian naming words for fruits and vegetables.
3. Discuss any 'tricks' to making connections to the pairs of words which may make it easier to remember. Eg **jeruk = orange** (the 'j' may be connected to juice which is connected to orange juice).
4. There is an excellent, easy to use, free website which uses these fruits and vegetables in an online game. It is called digitaldialect.com

MODIFICATIONS FOR OTHER YEAR LEVELS:

There are many ways to play Matching Games. Older students can design picture/word cards or pages for younger students to use.
